FROM THE DESK OF ORGANISING COMMITTEE

Children are the future of the nation, their health, growth and development is of utmost importance. During this critical period of growth and development there are many gaps which are actually missed opportunities for giving them the best of nutrition and care for their optimal growth and development. Nutrition is a foundation for healthy development. Poor nutrition leads to ill-health and ill-health contributes to further deterioration in nutritional status. These effects are most dramatically observed in young children, who bear the brunt of the onset of malnutrition and suffer the highest risk of disability and death associated with it. Anthropometric measurements are key tools for assessment of nutritional status and diagnosis of malnutrition, if not done regularly and routinely by the health & nutrition service providers, then these children miss the opportunity for nutritional assessment and detection of malnutrition. Now, we have facility based treatment for severe acute malnourished child, and not getting on-going community-based nutrition support they need, that is a missed opportunity. According to Lancet and World Bank report (2012), the under five mortality rate is 56 per one thousand live births and the child mortality report-2012, released by UNICEF has stated that India has the highest child mortality in the world. In India under five mortality rate remains alarming in spite of integrated and comprehensive nutrition and health care delivery system. Home Scientists can definitely contribute towards minimising missed opportunities in this regard through timely interventions.

The incidence of malnutrition rises sharply during the period from 6 to 24 months and the deficits acquired at this age are difficult to compensate for later in childhood. Optimal Infant and young child feeding ensure a child is protected from both under and over nutrition and their consequences.

Decision Tree allows for prioritization of strategies and selection of interventions appropriate for each local context. This include, counselling and education of mothers about optimal feeding and care practices and use of locally available foods, as well as strategies to improve availability and affordability of quality local foods. The Decision Tree would help with choosing additional components for the program, both in contexts where adequate local foods are available but supplementation may be needed to fill in nutritional gaps of local diets in certain groups/ areas or where there is generalized food insecurity.
