Dear Sir/Madam,


With reference to the above cited matter, it has been observed that the strict compliance of the rules regarding timely conduction of the RAC's and their subsequent approval from the respective DRC's are being not followed regularly by the most of the University Ressearch Departments/Centres which is a serious violation of the relevant rules/ regulations of the UGC as well as ordinances of the University.

In this regard, earlier, all the Heads/Directors were informed vide letter No. RS/2021/1073-1109 dated 22.06.2021 for strict compliance of the same ensuring the eriodically review and assessment of the research work carried out by every Research Scholar, as required under Ord. 124 (9.1- 9.5) of the Notification No. 20 and the same under Notification No. 15 too (as the case may be). A copy of the aforesaid letter is enclosed for your ready reference.

Hence, as per orders of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, you are again requested to ensure the compliance of the rules/ regulations in letter and sprit regarding conduction of the RAC's meeting in every six months for each research scholar and their subsequent approval by the respective DRC regularly, ^lotherwise, it would not be able for Research Section to accept any thesis of such candidates in future for evaluation.

Dear Sir/Madam,

As the University Rules/Ordinances for M.Phil./Ph.D. degree were amended vide Notification No. 15 dated 04.01.2017, in the light of 'UGC (Minimum Standard and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degrees) Regulations, 2016', which have been followed/ implemented in University for the admissions in M.Phil./Ph.D. programmes made through Uniraj-MPAT-2016 (Phase-I) and MPAT-2017 (Phase-II). Subsequently, incorporating some amendments made by the UGC, existing rules have come into force vide Notification No. 20 dated 27.11.2019, which have been followed for admissions made through Uniraj-MPAT-2018 (Phase-I & II).

Hence, in order to conformity and strengthen of the quality of research work and as per orders of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor dated 19.06.2021, you are requested to ensure the compliance of the rules/regulations strictly, provided under Notification No. 15 as well as Notification No. 20, respectively, keeping in view the following provisions for Ph.D. programme:

1. Progress report of every research scholar shall be placed to the DRC for consideration alongwith the recommendations made by the RAC, after presentation of the research work carried out by a candidate to the RAC once in every six months. In this regard, proper record shall be maintained at the Department level in each case.
2. Further, in later stage, on completion of research work by the candidate, if the DRC, after considering the recommendation of the RAC, finds the research work suitable for submitting the thesis in all aspects, it will recommend in very specific and clear words regarding the suitability of the thesis for submission to the University, alongwith a copy of the recommendation/ report made by the RAC for the same, subject to completing the required formalities in this regard.

3. Pre-Ph.D. presentation required before the submission of thesis, shall be made only after completion of minimum period of 03 years of the research work from the date of commencement.
4. University shall not issue any formal letter granting Extension/Re-registration, in these cases.
