
Office Order

The Admission of the following below mention teacher fellow has been cancelled ab initio because they had been admitted by violating the clause 6.5 of UGC regulation 2016 and the member of Academic Council who was present on dated 28.11.2018 had prepared counterfeit documents with dishonestly and fraudulently by violating the above mentioned UGC regulation. Furthermore it is expatiate to mention that the member of the academic council who were present on dated 25.10.2021 were also involved in preparing the above mentioned documents. The member of the syndicate who was present on dated 1.07.2019 had approved the recommendation of the academic council dated 28.11.2018 i.e. the counterfeit documents prepared by the member of the academic council. Furthermore the member of the syndicate who was present on dated 8th & 10th august 2019 affirmed the above cited documents. That the University of Rajasthan through vide notification no. 20 dated 27.11.2019 had inserted counterfeit documents under the clause no. 7.13 of the above mentioned notification.

It is pertinent to note that the Honorable Supreme Court in several of its judgments i.e., in the case of **Parneeth K and Ors versus University Grand Commission and Others Writ Petition (civil) No.724/2020, Gambhirdan K Gadhvi Vs the State of Gujarat and Ors. Writ Petition(civil) No.1525/2019, State of West Bengal Vs Anindya Sundar Das and Ors., Civil Appeal No. 6707/2022, Professor (Dr.) Sreejith P.S. Vs Dr. Rajasree M.S. and Ors. Civil Appeal No. 7634-7635/2022, and Professor Narendra Singh Bhandari Vs Ravindra Jugran and Ors. Civil Appeal No. 8184/2022** held that the UGC regulations are statutory and mandatory and even universities in the country cannot lay down any guideline or policy which would be in conflict with the centre statue or the standards lay down by the central body.

Furthermore in the Case of **Virendra Kapur vs University Of Jodhpur And Ors. on 13 February, 1964** Honorable High Court held that Section 24 lays down that Ordinances shall be made by the Syndicate but no such Ordinance shall take effect until it has been approved by the Chancellor after considering the views of the Senate and in case of **Fateh Krishan Kapil vs University of jodhpur and others D.B. Civil special appeal writ no. 312/2006** judgment of the Honorable Rajasthan High Court dated 07/04/2021 also state that on the recommendation of Academic Council , the syndicate have power to make ordinance but the ordinance should be passed in senate or they should be signed by Governor of Rajasthan after the whole procedure, the ordinance shall be in existence.


