ABOUT THE SEMINAR

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The department of Political Science was established in year 1962 in the University of Rajasthan, Jaipur. The founding Head of the department was Prof. S. P. Varma an eminent professor of Political Science in the country. The department flourished under dynamic leadership of notable scholars like Prof. Iqbal Narayan, Prof. V.R. Mehta, Prof. V.V. Raman Murty, Prof. C.P. Bhambri, Prof. K.P. Mishra, Prof. P.D. Sharma, Prof. Ramakant, Prof. Hargovind Pant, Prof. K.L. Kamal, Prof. D.B. Mathur, Prof. S.K. Asopa, Prof. Bhawani Singh and Prof. C.B. Gena.

Right from the inception, department soon acquired a reputation as the nursery of innovative teaching at the PG level. The department played a leading role as regard the updation of syllabi. Right from 1962 the Department faculty introduced many radical changes in the UG and PG syllabi existing un-changed in many older universities for more than three decades and soon these innovations spread all over India. The department has the credit of introducing the course on Modern Political Theory, but far-reaching changes were also made in courses relating to Comparative Politics and Indian Government and Politics with innovative features of both these courses getting introduced in many Universities all over India. This is only because of the efforts made by the department that Indian Political Thought has found place in U.G. and P.G. syllabi in the University of Rajasthan and in other Universities.

Within a decade or so of its foundation, the Department began to gain not only national but also international reputation with its quarterly Journal Political Science Review acquiring a high credibility. This journal was soon complemented by a Hindi counter-part viz Rajya Shastra Sameeksha.
