Event Specific Rules

Music Events

1. In Light Music Vocal: Bollywood or Hollywood songs are not allowed.
2. The participants of Classical Instrumental Competition must bring their own instruments and accompanist.

Dance Events

1. Wardrobe malfunctioning shall be considered as vulgarity and the team will be disqualified immediately .
2. The performance should not aspersion as caste, region, religion, gender or race.

Theater Events

1. Theme is open for all events.
2. The script of the street play should not reflect aspersion on any caste, region, gender or race.
3. Copy of the script should be submitted to our office by the team manager before 13th February 2023
4. If the attire is not found suitable for presentation, the participation will be cancelled.
5. No vulgar/offensive/abusive dialogues/recorded music shall be used by the participants. Such behavior shall result to immediate disqualification.

Visual Arts/Drawing & Painting Events

1. The participant's have to bring their own material/tools (paint & brush etc.)
2. Drawing Sheets/T-Shirt will be provided.
3. Acrylic/water colours can be used.
4. The topic of these competitions shall be declared on the spot.
5. For face painting: face shall be other than the participant.
6. For mehandi: hand should be the participant's.
