About the Department

The Department started in the year 1961. Special attention to the regularity, punctuality and sincerity of a student in class is given. If a student does not pass a course in which he/she is enrolled at the department at any level she/he will not be readmitted to the same language course under any circumstances. She/he can appear as an ex-student for the same examination in the next academic year. To declare a student eligible for appearing for the Final examinations of the Certificate, Diploma and Post-Diploma Courses in the Department, a student has to ensure 75% attendance in the given academic session and in addition, as per the Ordinance 215E, clear five class tests held throughout the year. There is no provision for Private Candidate in this department at any level. Two seats in each Language Certificate Course are allotted to the Govt, of India License holder Tour-Guides.

Employees in Private and / or Govt. Sector will have to attach a No Objection Certificate of their offices, if they desire to be admitted to these courses, as an adherence to the rule of 75% attendance as per the judgment of the Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court is mandatory.

- (i) In order to facilitate International Student Exchange programs, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur has signed MOU's with Jean Moulin University, Lyon, France and Aix-Marseille University, France. Under these agreements, students of French of the Department can pursue one semester in Universities in France at MA level. Scores of students of French have already been benefitted from these MOU's.
- (ii) The Department also has an active MOU with the Embassy of France in order to provide French Language Assistant to teach at the Department. The teacher is a native French speaker and engages special language enhancement skills classes for the

French students of the Department.

(iii) The Department has an active MOU with the Embassy of Spain in order to provide Spanish Language teacher to teach at the Department. The teacher is a native Spanish speaker and engages classes for the Spanish students of the Department.
